## Why should I take the time to do this?

### Abuse is prevalent!

Abuse of prescription drugs has increased among teenagers and young adults due to the ease of obtaining drugs. 70% of youth who abuse prescription drugs get them from family and friends.

### It's your environment – Please don't flush!

Drugs that are flushed down the toilet may pass through sewage treatment plants and septic tanks. These substances are released into waterways with the waste water which can lead to pollution of adjacent soil and ground water.

### You can make a difference!

Your unused drugs can be stolen and illegally sold. Take action to minimize the threat of accidental poisoning or drug abuse. Let's take precautions now to avoid harm to future generations and the environment.

## Drop These Items:

- ✓ Expired or Unwanted Prescription Medications
- ✓ Over-the-Counter Medications
- ✓ Controlled Substances (opiates, hallucinogens, and narcotics or amphetamines)

## Don't Drop These Items:

- ✗ Illegal Drugs
- ✗ Bio-Hazardous Materials
- ✗ Sharps / Needles
